

Synopsis of NCPBL Executive Council Meeting  
June 19, 2010

The North Carolina Phi Beta Lambda Executive Council met June 18-19, 2010, at the Clarion Hotel in Greensboro. All members of the Council were in attendance.

The minutes of the January meeting were approved. The state adviser reviewed the financial report.

It was reported NCPBL concluded the 2009-2010 year with 41 chapters and 734 members.

The Professional Division officers reported on PD activities.

Board of Directors President Chad Nichols reported on the NCPBL Foundation, Inc. A check from the Foundation for event sponsors and SLC support was presented to the state adviser. The Foundation also made a contribution to the national officer candidate campaign.

A report on the State Leadership Conference showed an attendance of 336 PBL members, PD members, advisers, and guests. Event changes for 2011 were reviewed.

The Council decided to post the 2010-11 State Handbook as soon as it is approved rather than holding it for distribution at the Kick-Offs.

Doing video newsletters was discussed.

During discussion on the 2010 Fall Leadership Development Conference, it was announced that the specialized tracks would be featured again.

The 2010-11 budget was approved. The national dues income and disbursement is not a part of the new budget since beginning with fall 2010 NCPBL would be using the national dues collecting program, with chapters submitted state and national dues directly to the national office rather than to the state adviser.

The Council approved changing Robbie McDonald's position from Financial Director to Professional Division Director.

Motions were passed to endorse John Anderson as a candidate for national president and to allocate funds for the campaign. A motion also passed to purchase a gift for Dawn Montoya to thank her for serving as a national officer.

The next Council meeting will be August 27-28.
